<p><b>SUNDAY</b> February 22 <i>Romans 12:1-2</i> Offer yourself as a living sacrifice--available for His service.</p>	<p><b>MONDAY</b> February 23 <i>Matthew 21:21-22</i> Ask for increased faith to believe. Do not doubt.</p>	<p><b>TUESDAY</b> February 24 <i>Colossians 3: 12-17</i> Pray that you may know and express the love and compassion of Christ and that the peace of Christ will reign in your heart.</p>	<p><b>WEDNESDAY</b> February 25 <i>Ephesians 4:11-16</i> Pray to mature into the stature of the fullness of Christ.</p>	<p><b>THURSDAY</b> February 26 <i>John 4:23-24</i> Worship the Father in spirit and truth.</p>	<p><b>FRIDAY</b> February 27 <i>Ephesians 1:15-23</i> Ask for the Spirit of wisdom and revelation for you and your family.</p>	<p><b>SATURDAY</b> February 28 <i>Luke 11:1-13</i> Thank Jesus for teaching you to pray.</p>
<p><b>SUNDAY</b> March 1 <i>Romans 8:25-28</i> Know that the Spirit helps you pray even when you aren't sure how to pray. 24-hour Prayer Vigil begins at 7pm</p>	<p><b>MONDAY</b> March 2 <i>Thessalonians 5:17-18</i> Pray to develop an attitude of gratitude and for intimacy in your prayer life. 24-hour Prayer Vigil ends at 7pm</p>	<p><b>TUESDAY</b> March 3 <i>1 John 5:14-15</i> Pray to know His will for you.</p>	<p><b>WEDNESDAY</b> March 4 John 3:16 Thank God for His ultimate sacrificial gift from His heart of love.</p>	<p><b>THURSDAY</b> March 5 <i>Mark 12:41-44</i> Pray that God will show you the meaning of sacrificial giving.</p>	<p><b>FRIDAY</b> March 6 <i>Deuteronomy 16:16b-17</i> Pray that you will use your God given talents in His service to the best of your abilities.</p>	<p><b>SATURDAY</b> March 7 <i>2 Corinthians 9:6-7</i> Ask God to reveal the motives of your heart.</p>
<p><b>SUNDAY</b> March 8 <i>Acts 20:35</i> Ask to learn the true joy of giving from the heart.</p>	<p><b>MONDAY</b> March 9 <i>2 Corinthians 9:9-15</i> Pray that as God supplies your needs, you may help supply the needs of others.</p>	<p><b>TUESDAY</b> March 10 <i>2 Corinthians 8: 1- 7</i> Pray for His Lordship in your life and that you would seek Him first.</p>	<p><b>WEDNESDAY</b> March 11 <i>Luke 6:38</i> Pray that your giving will no longer be a debt you owe but a seed you sow that will yield a harvest.</p>	<p><b>THURSDAY</b> March 12 <i>Matthew 6:19-21</i> Ask for discernment to choose between earthly treasures and heavenly treasures.</p>	<p><b>FRIDAY</b> March 13 <i>Philippians 1: 3-11</i> Thank God for His promise to complete what He has begun in you.</p>	<p><b>SATURDAY</b> March 14 <i>Ephesians 3:14-21</i> Trust that God is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that you ask or think.</p>
<p><b>SUNDAY</b> March 15 <i>Psalm 118:21-24</i> Rejoice and be glad for this is the day the Lord has made.
